The bolts fit in the head joint of the concrete block, setting securely between the blocks rather than in the core. The IPCO Masonry Anchor Bolt will not turn, twist or pull loose, and will always set straight for easy fitting of the sill plate.

IPCO Masonry Anchor Bolts save time by eliminating the labor used in filling the cores and setting the round bolts, as well as time spent straightening crooked bolts. Because they fit in the head joints, the bolts will always be evenly spaced and at the correct height.

IPCO Masonry Anchor Bolts are available in two configurations—single course anchorage or double course anchorage. Installation of the bolts is fast and easy and is done as the wall is being constructed, again saving time and labor spent installing standard round bolts. The bolts are supplied with nuts and washers for a complete installation. The multitude of sizes and dimensions available for the IPCO Masonry Anchor Bolts allow the bolts to fit almost any wall configuration and size requirement.

If hot-dip galvanized anchorage is desired, the IPCOTE Hot-Dip Galvanized Anchor Bolt is available. This bolt meets and exceeds the ASTM A-153 standard for hot-dip galvanizing to address the higher copper content of wood preservatives now in use. 

IPCO Masonry Anchor Bolts are to be installed as indicated in the drawings contained on this data sheet and as per single or double course anchorage. Bolts should be spaced a maximum of 48" on center. There should be a minimum of 2 bolts per plate section, with one bolt located no more than 8" nor less than 4" from each end of the plate section.


